Member Agreement

Members of Oakleaf's CSA receive a weekly share of fresh fruits and/or vegetables that will vary in size and weight depending on the season. Members agree to share in the inherent risks of agriculture that affect production (weather, rainfall, other unforeseeable acts) in return for the rewards (first pick of fresh, local, naturally produced fruits and vegetables).

The Farmers commit to working hard to provide no more than 50 shareholders with a variety of the freshest and healthiest seasonal produce we can grow using the most sustainable methods available including safe and responsible pest/disease management programs, natural fertilizers, and proper harvest, washing and storage techniques.

By signing this agreement, Members agree that there is no guarantee for the exact amount or variety of produce received. By participating in CSA, members are directly supporting their farmers and an equitable food distribution model. Members are also helping to create a more sustainable and economically healthy society.

I understand the above explanation of Oakleaf's CSA Membership Program and agree to accept explained risks and rewards. I commit to pick up my share weekly or arrange it so. I understand that my share CANNOT be saved or picked up at a later date and will revert to the farm for donation to a local charitable organization or resale. Refunds are not given for any reason. I have included full payment for shares reserved.
